Optional:	Introduce writing/forming numerals, 1 number per week.				
Example for how you might use a counting or activity book.	<u>Counting with Stickers</u> <i>Read pages 1-2, count together, have your child place the stickers and point to the 1 on the number line</i>	<i>Read pages 1-2, count together, have your child point to the 1 on the number line.</i> <i>Read page 3 or 3-4 (your page), have them place the stickers, count them, and count using the number line.</i>	<i>Read pages 1-4, count together, have your child point to the numbers on the number line.</i> <i>Read page 5, have them place the stickers, count them, and count using the number line.</i>	<i>Continue in this manner, spending 1 or two days for each number, giving your child the opportunity to count objects as well as associating quantity with the numeral.</i> <i>Increase pace as it suits your child's abilities.</i>
